#### □ PsycINFO

This database is published by the American Psychological Association. It contains citations and abstracts of journal articles, books, technical reports as well as dissertations in psychology and related disciplines. 90% of the 3,000+ titles indexed are peer-reviewed.

## □ Medline (1946+) via OvidSP

Produced by the United States National Library of Medicine, the MEDLINE database is widely recognized as the premier source for bibliographic and abstract coverage of biomedical literature. More than 8.7 million records from more than 3,600 journals are indexed, plus selected monographs.
