### · Finding h-index

H-index is a quantitative indicator that measures the impact of a researcher's outputs. For example, an h-index of 10 indicates that 10 papers of the researcher have at least 10 citations each.


To look up the h-index of a researcher, try these two Library databases: (1) Scopus or (2) Web of Science.

\*h-index on Scopus




In Scopus, look up an article by the author. Then click on the author's name.


Click "View h-Graph" to display an h-graph. Note that only articles published after 1995 are included in the calculation.


\*h-index on Web of Science


Locate any article by the author. Then click on the hyperlink next to his/name name.
