

Convert Cite-N-Write to CWYW™

- Users are recommended to complete the paper writing before switching reference management tools from RefWorks to EndNote.
- In case necessary, users are highly recommended to **BACK-UP** all the documents and references concerned before converting RefWorks' Cite-N-Write to EndNote's CWYW.
- Users are advised to refer to the steps in **official guide** in details (<http://endnote.com/kb/82809>). Steps in following slides are aimed at supplementing instead of replacing any steps in the official guide.

Converting a Document:

In order to convert a document created using RefWorks "Write-N-Cite" tools, it needs to be formatted in a custom style. Attached to this article is a custom style to perform the conversion. You will find a zipped copy of the custom style in the Attachments section to the right of this article.

1. Download the attached "convert_to_endnote.zip" file to your computer and unzip the "convert_to_endnote.rwb" file.
2. In RefWorks, go to Tools > Backup & Restore
3. Under Restore, be sure to only check "Include Output Styles." If References, Attachments, or RSS Feeds are selected, you risk overwriting any references you have in your account.
4. Click Browse to locate the "convert_to_endnote.rwb" file you downloaded in step 1.
5. Click the "Perform Restore" button.

You will now have a "Convert to EndNote" style in your list. You can then open your document and change styles to "Convert to EndNote."

Alternatively, you can customize an output style in RefWorks to achieve the same formatting. The Style Editing instructions can be found here:

- The in-text citation should be in the {Authors, Pub Year, Title} format for the best results.




9. Find "Convert to EndNote" style in "My Favourites"
